

Worship Ministry

Worship is the very nature of every human being. God created human beings to worship and to glorify Him. 90% of human beings living on this planet earth worship at least one God or some other nature or material beings. Songs we sing help us with words in worship. Music we make brings us to the reality of heavenly worship. Worship is more about life than techniques. People can easily remember a worship song or a short chorus rather than a bible verse in the lowest times of their lives.
