

MISSIONS: CAMBODIA 2006

The year 2006 brings about a continuation of many of our efforts in building our ministry in Cambodia. This year is a year of consolidation, a year where we reinforce and reaffirm our commitment to the various ministries we have started in previous years.

Agape Assembly, Toul Kork (Agape)

Agape continues to grow in numbers to 45. Agape now have Sunday worship, Youth Fellowship every Saturday afternoon and throughout the week we have different cell groups. People are coming to the Ministry Base everyday, making it a vibrant place. Some come to learn to lead in worship, how to sing new songs, how to play the guitar and other musical instruments. Others come just to learn the Word of God. This October we have another 15 new believers been baptised. We give praise and thanks to God for His sustaining hands and for the fruits that we are now beginning to witness.

FirstKids Cambodia (FKKC)

FKKC has started to recruit more teachers and support staffs in early 2006 to cater for the anticipated expansion for the October 2006 intake. This will move us into the next phase of training, which is to raise their level of professionalism as teachers, not only in academic education but also as teachers of the Word, of Jesus and His love for the children and their families. Continue to pray that we will find those who have the right attitude as servants of the Lord to be trained as future teachers & leaders.

English As Second Language (ESL)

The ESL continues to attract large numbers to our Ministry Base. We have deliberately charge a low fee (only USD2 per month) to encourage more to come through our doors. The fact that we can start the youth fellowship on Saturday afternoon is testimony to the success of ESL in reaching out to the young people of Cambodia.

Short-term missions trips

We have our 4 short-term missions trips for 2006;
